Handicap Flags

When approaching the green please remain on the cart path until just beyond the back edge of the green, then leave the path to park your cart 10 feet from the back edge of the fringe. Do not park your cart in front or on the side of the green except when the area behind the green is not accessible.

This rule applies in reference to all water's edge. Thank You!

UNDERSTANDING PACE OF PLAY

Pace of play is based on a foursome playing our golf course

Expectation

A foursome must play our golf course at a maximum of four hours; this applies to all other groups as well. Out of Position

To be behind pace, a group must be behind pace of play (time) and a gap must appear in between them and the group in front of them.

Additional Information

- Just because there's a gap doesn't mean the group in front of you is behind pace.
- Just because there's multiple groups on one hole doesn't mean there's a pace of play issue.
- If you are a single, twosome or threesome behind a foursome it's likely you'll play quicker than that group which could result in the smaller group frequently waiting. However, the foursome is entitled to their four hours regardless of the groups size behind them.

Why? You might ask...

Because pace is always based on time and a groups position on the golf course. If you can't check the box on both items, a group is not behind.
